LA REGLA

Aquí las tres formas son DISTINTAS: go → went → gone. Muchos participios de este grupo acaban en -en: seen, written, taken, given, broken. Si te suena a -en, es participio y va detrás de have.

¡Ojo! — el fallo típico. Usar el pasado donde va el participio: «I have went», «I have saw», «I have took». Detrás de have NUNCA va el pasado.
