LA REGLA

Estos diez cambian solo la VOCAL, y siempre en el mismo orden: i en el infinitivo, a en el pasado, u en el participio. Sing → sang → sung. Si te sabes uno, te sabes los diez.

¡Ojo! — el fallo típico. Saltarse la a del pasado y usar la u para todo: «I drunk a coffee». Drunk es participio; el pasado es drank.
