LA REGLA

En inglés el color va DELANTE del nombre y nunca cambia: a red car, two red cars. Aquí están los once colores de verdad, los modificadores light y dark, y las palabras que casi todo el mundo escribe mal.

¡Ojo! — el fallo típico. Poner el color detrás, como en español: «a car red». Es a red car, y en plural sigue igual: two red cars, nunca «two reds cars». Y el falso amigo: red es el color rojo; la red de casa es the network.
