LA REGLA

Casi todas las partes del cuerpo hacen el plural con -s: two hands, ten fingers. Solo dos se salen de la regla: tooth → teeth y foot → feet. Y hair no se cuenta: va en singular, my hair IS long.

¡Ojo! — el fallo típico. Los plurales inventados *tooths* y *foots*: son teeth y feet. Y el artículo: en español te duele «la» cabeza, pero en inglés la parte del cuerpo es de alguien — my head hurts, wash your hands, nunca *wash the hands*.
