LA REGLA

Con wear dices lo que llevas puesto; con put on, el momento exacto en que te lo pones. Y trousers, jeans, shorts, glasses, pyjamas y clothes son SIEMPRE plurales: van con are y se cuentan con a pair of.

¡Ojo! — el fallo típico. Fabric no es «fábrica»: fabric es la tela, y la fábrica es a factory. Y ojo con clothes: «ropa» es singular en español, pero en inglés es siempre plural — my clothes ARE dirty, nunca is dirty.
