OUT tira fuori qualcosa e la mette in vista. Find out è scoprire —l'informazione esce—, point out è segnalare, work out è risolvere, e sort out è sbrogliare un pasticcio. In tutti, qualcosa di nascosto finisce fuori.

¡Ojo! — el fallo típico. Confondere find e find out. Find è trovare un oggetto —I found my keys—; find out è venire a sapere qualcosa —I found out the truth—. Non si possono scambiare.
