## LA REGLA

UP qui non significa «su»: significa che qualcosa si completa o arriva al limite. Eat up è mangiare TUTTO, drink up è finire la bevanda, use up è consumare fino a non lasciare niente. Se capisci questo, metà di questi verbi si deducono da soli.

**¡Ojo! — el fallo típico.** Mettere il pronome dopo la particella: «turn on it», «pick up it». Quando l'oggetto è un pronome —it, them, me— va SEMPRE in mezzo: turn it on, pick it up.
