LA REGLA

Qui l'infinito cambia, ma passato e participio sono UGUALI tra loro: buy → bought → bought. È il gruppo più numeroso, e ci sono sottogruppi che fanno rima: -ought, -aught, -ept, -old.

¡Ojo! — el fallo típico. Inventare una terza forma che non esiste: «boughten», «taughten». Se passato e participio sono uguali, non c'è una terza forma da cercare.
