LA REGLA

Davanti a un animale si mette a, e an solo quando la parola comincia con un suono di vocale: a dog, a cat, ma an elephant, an owl, an ant. Al plurale quasi tutti prendono -s, ma mouse fa mice, goose fa geese, e sheep, fish e deer restano uguali: one sheep, ten sheep.

¡Ojo! — el fallo típico. Leggere «ape» come l'insetto: in inglese an ape è la scimmia grande, e l'ape che fa il miele è a bee. E sheep e fish al plurale non cambiano: three sheep, three fish.
