¡Ojo! — el fallo típico. Mettere il colore dopo, come in italiano: «a car red». È a red car, e al plurale non cambia: two red cars, mai «two reds cars». E la trappola italiana: un solo blue per blu e azzurro, e red non è «rete», è rosso.
