In inglese c'è cibo che si conta e cibo che non si conta. Con quello che non si conta —bread, milk, rice, water— non si mette a/an né un numero davanti: si dice some bread, a slice of bread, two glasses of milk.

¡Ojo! — el fallo típico. Dire «a bread» o «two milks». Ma le tue trappole vere sono altre: grape è «uva», non «grappa», e vegetables è sempre plurale, anche se «la verdura» in italiano è singolare.
