LA REGLA

In inglese la famiglia si impara in due pezzi: la parola (mother, uncle, niece) e il possessivo 's attaccato al possessore. E il possessore viene PRIMA: my father's brother è «il fratello di mio padre», letto al contrario.

¡Ojo! — el fallo típico. parents NON sono i parenti: sono la madre e il padre, nient'altro. I parenti —zii, cugini, nonni — sono relatives. E «nipote» in inglese diventa quattro parole: nephew, niece, grandson e granddaughter.
