LA REGLA

OFF significa que algo se SEPARA ou se corta. Take off é tirar a roupa —separa-se do corpo— e também descolar —o avião separa-se do chão—. Turn off corta a corrente. Call off cancela: corta o plano.

¡Ojo! — el fallo típico. Dizer «turn off it» ou «take off it». Com pronome, a partícula vai depois: turn it off, take it off.
