**¡Ojo! — el fallo típico.** Pôr a cor depois, como em português: «a car red». É a red car, e no plural não muda: two red cars, nunca «two reds cars». E o falso amigo: red faz lembrar «rede», mas é a cor vermelha; a rede é the network.
