LA REGLA

Quase todas as partes do corpo fazem o plural com -s: two hands, ten fingers. Só duas fogem à regra: tooth → teeth e foot → feet. E hair não se conta: é singular, my hair IS long.

¡Ojo! — el fallo típico. «Costas» é plural em português e back é singular: my back hurts, nunca *my backs hurt*. E hair nunca leva -s quando falamos do cabelo da cabeça: my hair is short, não *my hairs are short*.
