Com wear dizes o que trazes vestido; com put on, o momento exato em que o vestes. E trousers, jeans, shorts, glasses, pyjamas e clothes são SEMPRE plurais: levam are e contam-se com a pair of.

¡Ojo! — el fallo típico. Fabric não é «fábrica»: fabric é o tecido, e a fábrica é a factory. E cuidado com o verbo: em português «usa-se» uma camisa, mas em inglês não se diz I use a shirt — diz-se I wear a shirt.
